

MSI Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Guidance

This article aims to provide guidance to reuse and recycling facilities on materials and components of MSI products that require selective treatment as required by the EU WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU.

To ensure that information on materials requiring selective treatment in MSI products is available for at least seven years after the end of production, in accordance with the requirements of EU WEEE Directive [2012/19/EU Annex VII](#). This information is provided free of charge on our website for each product to ensure the disposal or recovery of WEEE.

Process notes:

1. Within six months of product launch, Corporate Sustainability Office (CSO) Team provides the product end-of-life disassembly instructions. This document should also help direct recyclers to proper methods for removing parts and general product disassembly instructions.
2. MSI maintains the above information and instructions for at least 7 years following the end of production of the product.
3. Post the completed product end-of-life disassembly instructions on 5.5.3 registered products service guide information for disposal or recovery:
